

# Official Rules

## Take It Outside: Guns 'N Gear

### Alabama Recreation and Parks Foundation

Tickets available through January 19, 2023, or until sold out

All proceeds from the event will benefit Outdoor Education classes and events in Hunting, Archery, Camping and Fishing; support the development of archery, fishing, and hunting clubs for kids, particularly in under-resourced areas of Alabama; support the re-forestation efforts in the State; and support grants and scholarship programs to encourage citizens to engage in the outdoor sports of archery, fishing, camping and hunting in the State.

- 1) Limit of 1500 tickets will be sold, numbering 0001 to 1500. Do not lose your raffle ticket as it is **required** to claim a prize.
- 2) Requested Ticket Donation - **\$50**. No limit to the number of ticket donations per person.
- 3) All prizes are new, factory-made gear. Archery, camping, fishing and hunting gear is available.
- 4) Tickets are transferable and make great gifts.
- 5) By donating to obtain a ticket (either by purchase or as a gift) you attest that you are a law-abiding citizen of good moral character, may legally possess the shotgun(s) won, have intention of using the shotgun(s) only in a legal and safe manner, and will or have already obtained instruction on the safe use and operation of the shotgun(s) won.
- 6) **Thirty ticket numbers will be drawn to be entered into a skills challenge to compete for prizes.** All sold or unsold 1,500 ticket numbers are in each drawing. (You can win more than once per ticket!) No prizes will be awarded on unsold ticket numbers drawn.
- 7) Drawing for entry into the skills challenge will be held on January 24, 2023. Holders of drawn tickets will be notified of entry into the skills challenge and may participate in person or by proxy (ARPF will provide a proxy). The skills challenge will take place January 30, 2023, at the Orange Beach Conference Center, Orange Beach, Alabama. You do not have to be present to win a prize. Three GRAND PRIZES will be drawn January 30, 2023, for entry into a skills challenge and all tickets are eligible for the drawing.
- 8) A specific piece of hunting, archery, camping or fishing gear is assigned a number from 1 to 30 and skills challenge winners will win prizes in order, 1-30. A list of prize items will be posted prior to the January 30 drawing.

- 9) All gear won is subject to availability and ARPF reserves the right to make substitutions of equal or greater value. Decisions on any substitutions are at the sole discretion of ARPF and Reynolds Outdoors.
- 10) Winning ticket numbers and gear won will be posted on the website [ARPAonline.org](http://ARPAonline.org), and on the ARPA Facebook Page. To protect the winner's identity, the winning names will not be posted.
- 11) Proceeds of the " **Take It Outside: Guns 'N Gear** " event benefit the Alabama Recreation and Parks Foundation, a 501c3 Corporation, and our community projects, as noted in the first paragraph of the Official Rules. - 12) You must be at least **18** years old and a legal resident of the United States to donate for a ticket.
- 13) Winners must be at least **18** years old to take possession of a shotgun.
- 14) Winner is responsible for all fees associated with any background check required to take possession of their prize.
- 15) Winners will be notified, using the name, address, email address, and/or phone number that the purchaser has written or requested be on the ticket stub. If ARPF is unable to contact the winner, it is the sole responsibility for the winning ticket holder to contact **Reynold's Outdoors, 904 Geneva Street, Opelika, AL 36801; 334.745.7642; reynoldsoutdoors.net** to claim their prize. **Winners MUST present their ticket to claim the prize won** (or provide an electronic copy if not local to the area). **ALL PRIZES MUST BE CLAIMED BY CLOSE OF BUSINESS DAY ON MARCH 31, 2023.**
- 16) All Federal Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (BATF) rules apply.
- 17) Winners will be responsible for any applicable Federal, State and local taxes.
- 18) Winners may be required to verify that ownership of the shotgun(s) won is legal in their state, city or town, prior to taking possession of the won prize(s).
- 19) ARPF makes no claim of shotgun suitability of the purpose of the shotgun won.
- 20) At no time will the Alabama Recreation and Parks Foundation take possession of any of the firearms or archery and fishing gear involved in this raffle; winners will receive firearms, archery and fishing gear directly from Reynold's Outdoors and all applicable laws will apply.
- 21) Camping gear will be directly shipped to the winner at the address furnished on the ticket.
- 22) By donating to obtain a ticket, you agree that ARPF's liability is limited to the donation price of the ticket.
